Registration & Payment

Registration is offered on a weekly basis. Pre-registration for both full day and wrap around Camp OC opens with Summer School registration Mar 4, 2024. Camp registration is posted on the Oak Creek Community Education & Recreation (OCRec) tab of the school district website. [Linked HERE] . Camp is part of our Childcare & Development category.

To register, select each week care is needed. Pay a non-refundable deposit for each week selected. Provide a credit card in the online registration system. The remaining balance will be taken on the Monday prior to the scheduled camp week.

Waitlist Process

When Camp OC registration reaches maximum capacity, your child will be placed on a waitlist. OCR will monitor registration and contact families as space becomes available. Fees are charged only after a camper is confirmed in the weekly program.

Caring for Self

All campers must be able to provide self care while in a group environment. Campers need to have mastered the following independent skills:

- Stay in a group
- Use the restroom
- Wash hands
- Eat on their own
- Change in/out of swim gear
- Listen and follow instructions

Daily Check In / Check out

Caregivers are required to sign in their camper each day.

Camp staff will monitor the morning drop off area from 7:00am-8:30am. Camp staff will monitor the evening pick up area from 4:30-5:45pm each afternoon. If you are arriving outside of these hours, please use the phone number provided in the confirmation email for camp staff to welcome or release your child.

List those authorized to pick up your child in your registration information or update staff in advance of any changes.

Lunch, Snacks & Special Days

Campers should pack a healthy lunch, morning and afternoon snacks and water bottle for each day of camp. If your child is celebrating a birthday with us, you are welcome to bring a snack for their group. Ask their counselor for group counts. If offering a snack for everyone, we ask they be pre-packaged and peanut free.

On occasion, we will be providing a snack or specialty item as part of the camp day. Staff will share days and snack offerings with advance notice in weekly confirmation updates. Parents are to note any food allergies at time of registration so we can include as many campers as possible. We do offer alternatives for those unable to participate in a group treat.

Sunscreen & Bug Spray

We spend a lot of time outside. Caregivers should apply sunscreen and bug spray prior to arriving at camp. Send your child with labeled spray sunscreen and repellant for camp staff to apply throughout the day. Camp staff will not apply lotion sunscreen to campers.

Medication

If your child requires medication during the camp day, make sure you have a completed Medical Consent Form on file with OCR. We can not accept outdated forms that may expire with the school year. Camp OC staff are trained by the district nurses to administer epi pens and inhalers. Contact our office for administration of any other medications or care needs.

Emergency Response

Staff are trained in First Aid and CPR/AED, and will be able to conduct an initial assessment to determine next steps. If your child becomes ill or is injured while at camp, staff will assess the need and notify caregivers if warranted. Parents will not receive a call each time a child receives a bandaid or ice pack. If your child experiences an injury requiring more than basic first aid, staff will take the following action:

- Call 911 for emergency medical support
- Contact Parent/Guardian. If unable to be reached, the staff will call listed emergency contacts.

If a child requires additional medical attention, the child will be accompanied by a camp staff member and transported by ambulance to Ascension Hospital on 27th Street.

Parent Responsibilities

Keep staff informed with updated and relevant information about the well being of your child. Sharing updates at drop off or pick up is a great way to keep our on site staff informed of your child's needs and learn about their day.

If your child is ill they need to be symptom-free for 24 hours before returning to camp. This would include fever, vomiting or intestinal discomfort. Notify us when your child is not attending camp as scheduled.

Make sure all contact information is current. Confirm alternate authorized pick up information. Dress your child for the weather and a full and active day.

Pack a swim suit and towel daily as we often have water play activities included in the camp day.

Consider your child's needs and pack a spare set of clothing.

Field Trips

Camp OC staff have designed, age appropriate off site field trips for some of our full day weekly camps. Those weeks where we are not offering an off-site trip, there will be special guests, events or activities fitting the weekly theme.

All off-site field trips, require parents to complete the electronic Parent Permission Slip provided at time of registration. Additional permission slips may required by a hosting facility. Those will be noted in the field trip permission form and included in the weekly confirmation email and required prior to a child departing for the trip.

Camp OC staff will accompany your child on the trip and will use all reasonable precautions with regard to safety and general welfare. If, for behavioral/disciplinary reasons, a camper must return from the trip early and separate from the participating group, parent/guardians will be responsible for any additional incurred trip expenses.

Camp OC may offer walking field trips within the community and parks. All will be within reasonable walking distance from camp. If any items would be purchased they would be at the campers expense. Participation and purchase is not required. Locations will be listed on site with sign out permission offered each week.
