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Registration & Payment

Wrap Around Care registration is offered as a 4-week package for summer school before school care and after school care options. Registration opens with Summer School registration March 4, 2024 and is offered on a space-available basis. Full Day and Wrap Around Care Camp registration is posted on the Oak Creek Community Education & Recreation (OCRec) tab of the school district website. [Linked HERE]. Camp is part of our Childcare & Development category.

Registration is pre-paid for selected four-week packages. To receive a refund for Wrap Around Care services, notification must be made by June 10. If canceling before June 10, families may select a full credit to their rschool account or a refund to the credit card used for payment, minus a 10% processing fee.

Waitlist Process

When Camp OC registration reaches maximum capacity, your child will be placed on a waitlist. OCR will monitor registration and contact families as space becomes available. Fees are charged only after a camper is confirmed in the program.

Caring for Self

All campers must be able to provide self care while in a group environment. Campers need to have mastered the following independent skills:

- Stay in a group
- Use the restroom
- Wash hands
- Eat on their own
- Listen and follow instructions

Daily Check In / Check out

Before School Participants - Caregivers are to call the phone number provided in the confirmation notice, and posted on site, to alert staff of child check in. Parents are required to sign in their camper each day.

After School Participants - Camp staff will monitor the evening pick up area from 4:30-5:45pm. If you are arriving before 4:30, please use the phone number provided in the confirmation email for camp staff to release your child to your care.

List those authorized to pick up your child in your registration information or update staff in advance of any changes.

Lunch, Snacks & Special Days

Campers should pack a healthy lunch, afternoon snack and water bottle for each day of camp. If your child is celebrating a birthday with us, you are welcome to bring a snack for their group. Ask their counselor for group counts. If offering a snack for everyone, we ask they be pre-packaged and peanut free.

On occasion, we will be providing a snack or specialty item as part of the camp day. Staff will share days and snack offerings with advance notice in weekly confirmation updates. Parents are to note any food allergies at time of registration so we can include as many campers as possible. We do offer alternatives for those unable to participate in a group treat.

Sunscreen & Bug Spray

We spend a lot of time outside. Send your child with labeled spray sunscreen and bug repellant for students to apply in the afternoon. Camp staff will not apply lotion sunscreen to campers.

Medication

If your child requires medication during the camp day, make sure you have a completed Medical Consent Form on file with OCR. We can not accept outdated forms that may expire with the school year. Camp OC staff are trained by the district nurses to administer epi pens and inhalers. Contact our office for administration of any other medications or care needs.

Emergency Response

Staff are trained in First Aid and CPR/AED, and will be able to conduct an initial assessment to determine next steps. If your child becomes ill or is injured while at camp, staff will assess the need and notify caregivers if warranted. Parents will not receive a call each time a child receives a bandaid or ice pack. If your child experiences an injury requiring more than basic first aid, staff will take the following action:

- Call 911 for emergency medical support
- Contact Parent/Guardian. If unable to be reached, the staff will call listed emergency contacts.

If a child requires additional medical attention, they will be transported by ambulance to Ascension Hospital on 27th Street, accompanied by a camp staff member.

Parent Responsibilities

Keep staff informed with updated and relevant information about the well-being of your child. Sharing updates at drop off or pick up is a great way to keep our on site staff informed of your child's needs.

Your child needs to be symptom-free for 24 hours before returning to camp. This would include fever, vomiting or intestinal discomfort. Notify us when your child is not attending camp as scheduled.

Make sure all contact information is current. List those authorized to pick up your child in your registration information or update staff in advance of any changes.

Dress your child for the weather and a full and active day.

Consider your child's needs and pack a spare set of clothing.
